On Wednesday morning The Ecuador team will leave from the Pensacola airport for what we pray will be another fruitful mission. The following scriptures reveal how the mission of God was fulfilled through Jesus Christ and how we are called to serve as missionaries in our own society:

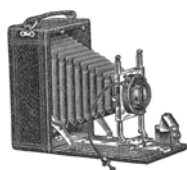
- * Jesus said to them, "My food is to do the will of him who sent me and to accomplish his work." ([John 4:34](#))

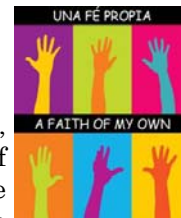
